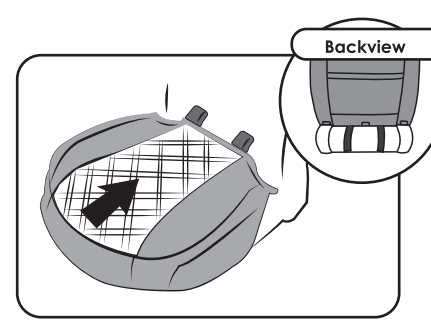
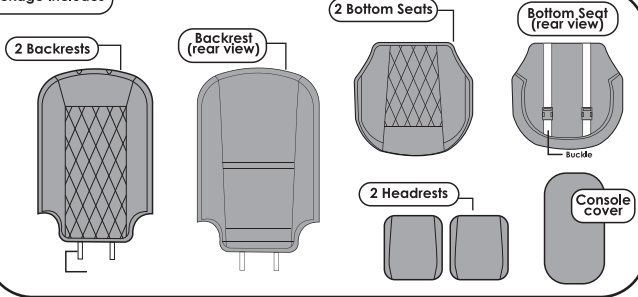

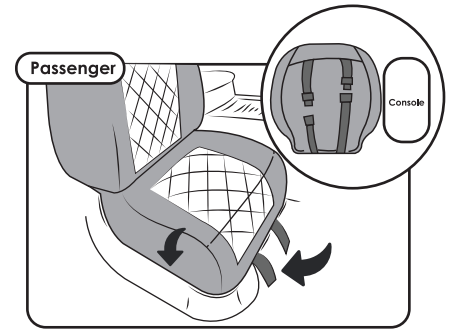
Warning

- We suggest wearing protective eyewear and gloves during installation.

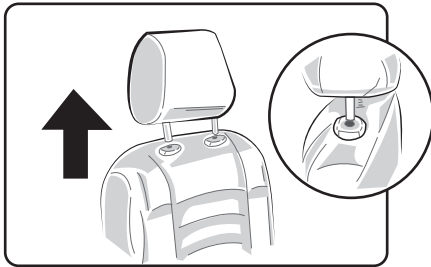

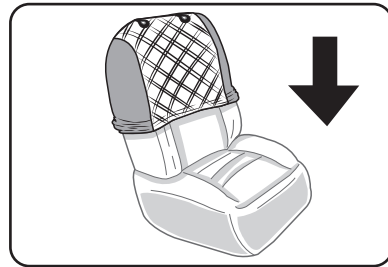
6 To install the bottom cover, place it on the seat and push the buckle straps through the seat crevice. Then, pull them out from the backside of the seat as shown in the image above.



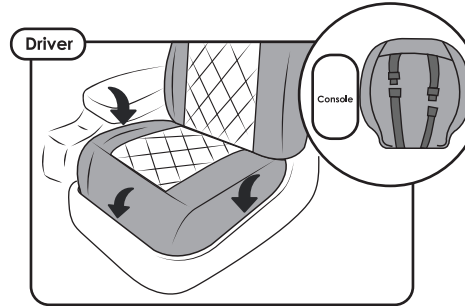
7a Tuck in the bottom cover around the seat, especially next to the center console, to ensure a snug fit. Finally, attach the buckle straps underneath the seat. TIP: Use a plastic tool to tuck in the cover easily.



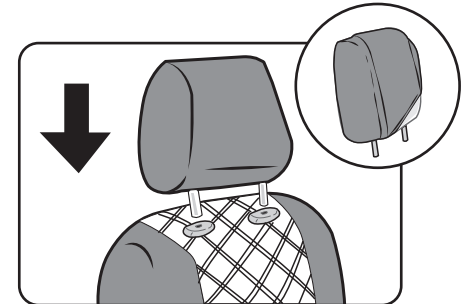
1 Detach the headrest by pressing the button located at the base of the headrest. Then simply lift the headrest to separate it from the backrest.



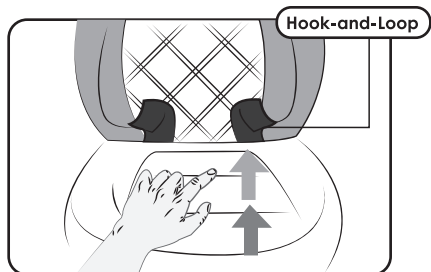
2 Place the backrest cover over the seat making sure the headrests openings are aligned accordingly.



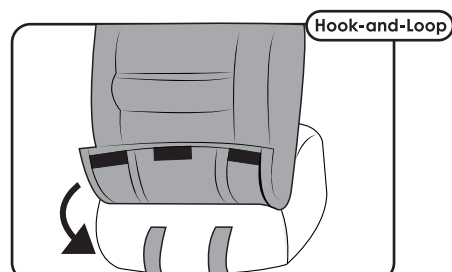
7b Repeat the same process to install the bottom cover of the driver seat. Don't forget to tuck in the cover around the seat, especially next to the center console.



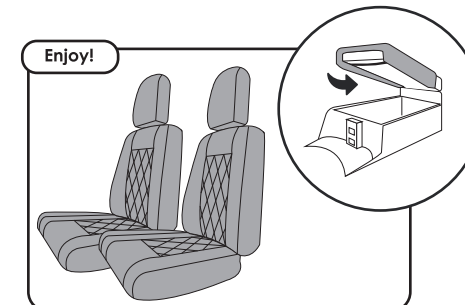
8 Slip on the headrest cover. TIP: Starting from either side of the headrest and sliding the cover sideways will help you achieve a secure fit. Finally, reattach the headrest to the top of the car seat.



3 Push the straps through the seat crevice, and position the straps to the back of the seat.



5 Locate the hook-and-loop straps at the back of the backrest cover and attach them directly to the car seat's upholstery.



9 Adjust accordingly and smooth out your custom-fit seat cover. Lastly, slide on the console cover over the center console and enjoy!
